

## RULES & REGULATIONS

**IMPORTANT NOTICE:** All steers must be tagged with CCIA National ID Tags. Each Club, following the Sale, must leave sufficient hay to feed those steers being railed.

1. a) All market animals must be put to auction at Yorkton Regional Show.  
b) All open class entries must be shown and put to auction.
2. All market animals entered in the Show and Sale must be properly dehorned and castrated. All Leaders must enforce this.
3. **All animals must have their ear tags & CCIA Tags in place at time of weigh-in.**
4. **Color & color enhancing products will not be allowed at the Show.**
5. Club Leaders must declare breed of animal at weigh-in and animals must compete in breed classes as declared throughout the Show.
6. The Club Leader shall provide a list with member names and breed sire to weigh-master at the time of weigh-in.
7. Each 4-H Member must show his or her animal with exceptions only as approved prior to the class by Sales Manager and Club Leader.
8. All exhibits must be on the grounds and weighed by Tuesday, June 30, at 5:00 pm. **Note:** Scale to be open at 4:00 pm with option open to weigh at 4:00 pm, but all animals must be in to weigh by 5:00 pm. All market animals will be weighed prior to the sale on a 3% shrinkage basis and settlement made on the final weight. **No cattle are allowed outside of the paneled area. No animals are to leave the grounds until after the sale.**
9. Selling and operating charges on animals will be determined after sale.
10. Brand inspections must be taken on all livestock and a brand inspection release is needed for removal of sale animals.
11. Stabling and water will be provided at no charge.
12. Association reserves the right to pay prizes on the percentage basis of prizes offered, should they find themselves financially embarrassed.
13. **Entry Fees:** \$20 for Heifer, Cow-Calf & Open Steer Class Entries.
14. **Entry Deadline:** All entries for **females and steers** must be in by **Friday, June 5th** & will be strictly adhered to. **There will be a \$20 per animal penalty fee for late entries.**
15. **All females being shown must make entry. Entry must be submitted, indicating birth dates and breed of animal, and fees must accompany entry. Entry Deadline is Friday, June 5th.**
16. Class Splits on the Steers will be by weight - lightest to heaviest; Class Splits on the Heifers will be by age – youngest to oldest.
17. If there are 6 or more Straight Bred Heifers there will be a Straight Bred Heifer Class for that breed.
18. All Open Class entries are subject to inspection by the Culling Committee prior to the Show. Steers must be owned for 130 days.
19. **Clover Bud** members will show in the Clover Bud Class and have the option to show in the weight class; heifers may move on to the breed class if they so wish, steers can sell in the regular sale with their club.
20. To be eligible for prize money, clubs must have entries in all Club Classes in which they qualify.
21. All females entered must comply with the current Saskatchewan Health Regulations.
22. All animals shown must have a completed record book and have been shown at their local Achievement Day.
23. Record Books must have Achievement Day Judge Score Sheet inside in order to be eligible for competition at the Regional Show.
24. Decision of Judges and Directors will be final.
25. The Association reserves the right to refuse entry to anyone who is not in good standing with Yorkton 4-H Regional Beef Show & Sale.
26. Liability: Not withstanding anything to the contrary herein contained, it is understood that each consignor waives all claims against the Yorkton Exhibition Assoc., and/or any of its members, officials, or agents thereof, for any and all injury, loss, damage, which he/she, his/her employees, helpers, and/or property may sustain by the said Association by reason of any claims made by any of his helpers or assistants introduced to or engaged shall be at the sole risk and responsibility of such consignors.
27. Members are responsible for their own clipping & grooming of the animals, but when safety is an issue, handling of the animal by a parent or leader would be permitted.

The association will also present a promotional gift to each member showing a Hereford-influence animal, providing the animal is entered as Hereford or Hereford-influence, either sire or dam. Photo required.

### Saskatchewan Charolais Association

The Association will award an embroidered jacket to the member showing the Grand Champion &/or Reserve Grand Champion Charolais sired steer, heifer, cow/calf pair over all breeds. These will be presented at Agribition, if possible. All 4-H members are to receive a promotional item providing they show a Charolais influenced animal.

### The Saskatchewan Shorthorn Association

Will award a \$250 Purchase Certificate for Grand Champion Steer or Female and a \$100 Certificate to the Reserve Champion Steer or Female provided it is one half or better Shorthorn breeding and show strong Shorthorn characteristics and at time of entry Shorthorn breeding is stated. The purchase certificate will be honored provided that animal is purchased at any Shorthorn Assoc. sanctioned sale in Saskatchewan and will expire December 31<sup>st</sup> of the following year. ### The Saskatchewan Simmental Association

Will award a "Champion" jacket/hoodie to the overall Grand Champion & Reserve Champion Steer, Yearling Heifer, 2 year old and calf, and 3 year old with calf classes, provided the animal is 50% or more Simmental. ### Prince Albert Exhibition Association

Will award a free entry to the open show at the 2015 Summer Fair to following winners at a 2014 Regional 4-H Show: Grand & Reserve Champion Heifer Calf, Bull Calf, Yearling Heifer, 2 year old Cow/Calf Pair, 3 year old Cow/Calf Pair, Champion Female. Open to both purebred and commercial cattle; entry must be made prior to July 11, 2015.

### Saskatchewan Limousin Association

Will present a Limousin award to the exhibitor of the Overall Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Steer, Heifer and Cow/calf pair, provided the animal is entered as a Limousin or Limousin-influence – either sire or dam influence. Photo required.

### Man/Sask Gelbvieh Association

Will offer an award to a member showing a 50% or greater Gelbvieh animal that wins Grand or Reserve Champion over all breeds.
