RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Yorkton Exhibition Association. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. Entry fee: \$40.00/team (\$20.00 stall fee included).
3. NOTE: Arrival Times: Horses may enter the barns after 8:00 AM, Wednesday, November 7, 2018.
4. Teamsters 15 years of age and younger may receive assistance with hooking and unhooking.

CHORE TEAM RULES

Teams must perform at a controlled walk or trot.

1. Teamster comes to gate and drapes or drops lines, opens gate, drives through, and closes gate. Assistant may stand behind the team for safety purposes as the gate is worked. If the assistant has to pick up the lines for a team that won't whoa, points for that obstacle will be lost.
2. Timing begins when team crosses chalk line at the gate.
3. Teamster drives into keyhole to a l wagon, hooks team to wagon unassisted. Assistant must wait outside the keyhole until team is hooked. Once hooked, teamster turns wagon 180 degrees without touching the chalk line and drives out of keyhole. When hooking the wagon, teamster and team must stay inside the chalk mark outlining the keyhole.
4. Team and wagon move into the corner alley obstacle. Rails are situated to allow only enough room for team and wagon to make it through the maneuver.
5. Team and wagon execute a figure eight around cones.
6. Team and wagon then move to the parallel Parking area.
7. Team backs wagon to the dock
8. Team drives back into the keyhole and parks wagon for next contestant. Helper must leave the keyhole while the teamster unhooks wagon and exits the keyhole. Timing stops when wagon tongue touches the ground. Team must successfully exit keyhole to receive total points. Event management will ensure the wagon is returned to a universal starting point for next team.
10. Team exits arena at a controlled walk.

BARREL RACE RULES

1. Set pattern must be followed.
2. Time will start and end when neck yoke crosses start/finish line.
3. Pattern must be completed at either a walk or trot.
4. If a horse(team) breaks into canter at any time team will be disqualified.
5. Broken pattern will result in a disqualification.
6. Time faults will be added for every barrel knocked over.

FEED TEAM RACE RULES

Objective: The objective of this event is to drive a team through and around the course stopping at 3 feed stations to pick up and drop off feed bales.

Driver cannot touch bales. Helper cannot fall off or be left behind.

1. Time starts/stops when the neck yoke passes over the start/finish line.
2. Teams must be kept at a walk or trot. Five (5) penalty points will be added to the driver's score each time the team breaks into a lope.
3. Team must be completely stopped as bales are placed on or taken off the sled. Five (5) penalty points will be added to driver's score if team is not completely stopped at each Feed Stop.
4. The driver and helper must both ride on the sled except when loading and unloading feed. Both must be on the sled before the team starts and/or stops. Five (5) points will be added if both are not on the sled when the sled begins moving.
5. Twenty (20) penalty points will be added for each bale that has been broken.
6. At each Feed Stop both bales must be placed completely on the plywood square. If any part of the bale is not on the square, a 5 point penalty will be added to the driver's score (a possible 10 points added – 5 for each bale/sack not on the plywood).
7. Twenty (20) penalty points will be added to the driver's score for each break in the pattern.
8. Points will determine placings. Each driver begins with ZERO points. The driver with the LOWEST points at the end of the event is the winner. Each individual performance will be timed and the time will be used as a tie-breaker.
