Planning is underway for the 2018 4-H Spring Steer & Heifer Show to be held April 5 – 7, 2018. This year's show promises to be another great event for everyone and we hope that your club will join us for the competition!

Please note, the 2018 schedule has changed somewhat from previous years. As such please review the Prize Book carefully. One change of note is the Showmanship classes will be held Friday morning and will be DRY.

We ask that Club Leaders review and verify that all information on all entries is complete and correct prior to submission. As in previous years, all entries **MUST** be submitted together along with **ONE** cheque for fees (see rule 10).

New this year, we are asking all 4-H members who plan to attend the event in any capacity to indicate this on the registration forms. If you have members attending, but not bringing animals, please register them on the Club Entry Form. All registered members will receive a "participant wristband" to be worn for the duration of the event.

In addition, we are looking to implement "Show Coaches" during this years' competition. These individuals will be recent graduates from 4-H that are willing to spend some time assisting some of the younger members in various capacities. Some members still require a bit of guidance in preparing their animals and these individuals will be on site to do just that. If your club knows of anyone that might be interested in serving as a "Show Coach", please make note on the Club Entry Form.

Show Information

ENTRY LIMIT: Entries will be limited to 250 steers/heifers and will be accepted on a first come basis.

PLEASE GET YOUR ENTRY IN EARLY!

ENTRY DEADLINE: Wednesday, March 21, 2018

ARRIVAL: Barns will be open on Wednesday, April 4th for early arrival and on Thursday, April 5th between 8 am and 12 noon. **CATTLE MUST BE IN THE BARN BY 12:00 NOON.**

TRAILER PARKING: All 4-H parking, trucks and trailers, must be in the far East portion of the parking lot by Tim Horton's (along East fence).

STABLING: Cattle will be stabled in the Ag Arena & Industrial Building. All animals from a club **MUST** be stabled together. There is to be **NO** advertising of any kind of individual farms. **NO STRAW WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE BARN.**

TIE OUTS: Available between the cattle buildings at the owners' risk. **Tie-outs will be designated by club.** First bedding of straw will be provided.

WEIGHING: 12 noon - 3 pm, Thursday, April 5th. All workshop and show entries will be finalized at this time.

WASH RACK: Open from 6 am to 11 pm and during Show hours - enter from **EAST** door **ONLY**.

CLIPPING/TRIMMING: All clipping/trimming is to be done in designated areas **ONLY**, and is to be done by the youth member. **All trim chutes MUST have Club Identification posted on chute.**

CCIA TAGS: **ALL CATTLE MUST BE CCIA TAGGED.** - No exceptions!

Please ensure that ALL birth dates and breeds are correct. There will absolutely be NO changes after the deadline date.

LIABILITY: Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein contained, it is understood that each exhibitor waives all claims against the Yorkton Exhibition Assoc., and/or any of its members, officials, or agents thereof, for any and all injury, loss, damage, which he/she, his/her employees, helpers, and/or property may sustain by the said Association by reason of any claims made by any of his helpers or assistants introduced to or engaged shall be at the sole risk and responsibility of such exhibitor.

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Any exhibitor not complying with the rules and regulations made to govern exhibitors and their exhibits during the show may, at the discretion of the Directors, forfeit all or any portion of the prize money won with his/her exhibits.
2. All entered exhibitors shall be under the control of the Association, but they will in no case be responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may occur. It shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Association blameless for any loss, accident or injury.
3. The decisions of the judges shall be final.
4. The Committee reserves the right to decide any points not covered by the prize list, and in all cases, their decision shall be final.
5. **Alcoholic beverages and smoking will not be allowed in the Barn. This will be enforced.**
6. **All Cattle MUST be CCIA tagged.**

7. Only dehorned or polled animals are eligible to be shown in the steer classes. Scurs are not to be greater than 2 inches (5cm) in length.
8. Cattle must be well halter broken. No vicious or unruly animals may be shown or be kept in the stables with any other exhibitors'.
9. All entries must be in the hands of the Yorkton Exhibition Office by 4:30 p.m., **Wednesday, March 21. No changes and/or substitutions will be accepted after the entry deadline date or at weigh-in.**
10. **All CLUB entries must be done as ONE club, with ONE cheque. Club leaders will be responsible for reviewing & making sure all information is correctly filled out prior to submission of entry. Club leaders may be contacted to review entries with Committee.**
11. Show is open to 4-H members and Clover Bud Exhibitors under the age of 21 years as of December 31, 2017.
 - Clover Bud – Between 6 & 8 years of age as of Dec. 31, 2017
 - Junior - Between 9 & 12 years of age as of Dec. 31, 2017
 - Intermediate - Between 13 & 15 years of age as of Dec. 31, 2017
 - Senior - Between 16 & 21 years of age as of Dec. 31, 2017
12. Each participant may show one steer and/or heifer. Clover Bud participants are eligible to show in the regular show with paid entry.
13. It is mandatory to be entered in the Open Show before entering in the Jackpot Show.
14. Entry into Showmanship classes is automatic and mandatory. **All Showmanship classes will be DRY – no exceptions!!**
14. **All Heifers/Steers entered in the Show must be the members' own 4-H project animal.**
15. All participants must wear a show harness when in the ring.
16. Heifers will be split by breed and if not 3 animals per class will be put into a mixed breed class and split by age.
17. Group Classes – Clover Bud Exhibitors & bonafide members enrolled in a 4-H Beef Club are eligible to compete. All animals must have been shown in the Open Show single classes.
18. No ribbons won in previous classes are allowed to be carried into the show ring.
19. The exhibitor whose name is on the entry form at the time of entry is the person responsible for showing the said animal(s). NO OTHER family member or exhibitor will be allowed in the show ring with the said animal(s), notwithstanding Clover Buds. No other exceptions to this rule will be made.
20. **Any false representation, interference, or ungentlemanly conduct on the part of an exhibitor or parent will be dealt with by the Committee according to each particular case.**
21. It is the responsibility of the 4-H member to keep the barn area and clipping area clean throughout the Show and to remove manure nightly.
22. **Only 4-H members and Clover Bud Exhibitors are allowed to fit (wash, clip, groom) their calves. ONLY 4-H members entered in the show are able to assist other members in fitting. Wristbands must be worn by participants in the show so non-competitors can be easily identified. When safety is an issue, handling of the animal by a parent or leader may be permitted. This rule will be policed by the Committee. Any entries found to violate this rule will be disqualified.**

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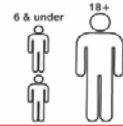

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NEW on July 4th! Swim Admission Process

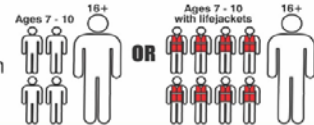
RED Bands

- All children 6 and under MUST be accompanied by a parent/guardian (18+ years)
- Children must remain within direct supervision and within arm's reach
- Maximum of 2 children per each parent/guardian (1:2)



YELLOW Bands

- Children 7 to 10 years MUST be accompanied by a parent/guardian (16+ years)
- Children must remain within direct supervision and within arm's reach
- Maximum of 4 children per each parent/guardian (1:4)



GREEN Bands

- Children 7 to 10 years who pass the Waterpark Admission Swim Test MAY swim unaccompanied
- Children with green bands may be asked to take the test again if aquatic staff are concerned that they cannot demonstrate the ability to maintain the Waterpark Admission Swim Test
