



# Yorkton Agricultural & Industrial Exhibition Association Ltd. Grandstand Tag Raffle

## Rules of Play

1. Grandstand Tag Raffle tickets will be sold:

a. In person or by phone during regular business hours at the Yorkton Exhibition office starting each Thursday morning and continuing each regular business day until 4 pm the following Wednesday.

b. Payments will be accepted by e-transfer to [info@yorktonexhibition.com](mailto:info@yorktonexhibition.com) and deposited directly into the Yorkton Agricultural & Industrial Exhibition Association Ltd. Grandstand Tag Raffle account starting 8:30 am each Thursday morning until 4 pm the following Wednesday.

c. Any e-transfer tickets purchased after 4 pm will have the confirmation photo sent the next regular business day. A physical copy of the ticket is available upon request.

d. E-transfer tickets must have first and last name (one person) and cell number in the message box.

e. Tickets can be ordered and paid for on the Yorkton Exhibition website at [www.yorktonexhibition.com](http://www.yorktonexhibition.com). A ticket will be filled out manually and the ticket or copy will be sent to purchaser through either email, text or mail.

f. Tickets may also be purchased in person on some weekends at special events at the Yorkton Exhibition. Watch the website [www.yorktonexhibition.com](http://www.yorktonexhibition.com) or the Yorkton Exhibition Association Facebook page for updates.

2. A designated Draw Supervisor, Proxy and a Representative from the Yorkton Exhibition will conduct the draw procedure. The Proxies for this raffle will be Myrna Grunert and Jan Morrison. The Proxy's only job is to be available to draw a tag if the winner is not present.

3. Ticket sales:

a. Sales are restricted to those 19 years of age and older.

b. Each ticket must have only one legible full name and phone number with area code.

c. The Draw Supervisor, Ticket Sellers, Proxy, MC and Yorkton Exhibition representative for that draw are not permitted to purchase tickets; all other volunteers, including Yorkton

Exhibition staff, volunteers and Directors are permitted to purchase tickets.

d. Ticket sales will be limited to city of Yorkton and surrounding communities residents only.

e. Ticket sales will be sold between September 3, 2020 – September 8, 2021.

4. A total of 200,000 tickets at \$10.00 per ticket will be available for sale for this raffle.

5. For the first raffle only, \$1,000 will be added to the pot. The total prize value will be up to a maximum of \$1,001,000.00.

6. The draw will be made every Thursday beginning September 10, 2020 and concluding Thursday, September 9, 2021 at 12:00 noon at the Yorkton Exhibition Office located in the Concourse of the Gallagher Centre, 455 Broadway St. W., Yorkton, SK.

7. Distribution of Proceeds:

a. One winning ticket will be drawn for 20% of the weekly ticket sales and a chance to pick the designated tag. 52 tags will be numbered #1 through to #52 inclusive. The designated tag will be marked with the letters YE. The designated tag will be #52 YE. The tags will decrease by 1 tag each draw date.

b. 30% of the weekly sales will go into the Grandstand Tag jackpot

c. 50% of the weekly sales will go to the Yorkton Exhibition Association to be used for the Grandstand Rejuvenation Project.

d. If the winning tag is selected the very first event, the winner will receive the consolation prize of 20% of weekly sales as well as the jackpot which would be 30% of weekly sales plus the \$1,000.00 that was added to the first event only.

8. Draw Procedure:

a. The draw procedure will be visible for participants to see as well as be broadcast live on Facebook.

b. The draw supervisor or Yorkton Exhibition representative will draw a ticket from the draw barrel. Short sleeves must be worn or sleeves rolled up when conducting the draw.

c. The name drawn will be announced verbally at the draw and will be displayed visually. If the winner is in attendance, that person will then have the chance to pick a tag.

d. If the person whose name is drawn is not in attendance the Proxy will immediately pick a tag

for them.

e. Before the draw, the remaining tags will be displayed in such a manner as to confirm that the designated tag #52 YE is still in play.

f. After confirmation that tag #52 YE is in play, the weekly draw winner/Proxy must select one tag.

g. Once draw winner/Proxy has selected their tag, the draw supervisor will remove all remaining tags and the selected tag is displayed revealing it's number and declaring it the winning tag for that week.

9. If tag #52 YE is turned up the winner receives the amount in the Grandstand Tag jackpot, which also includes 30% of the weekly ticket sales.

10. If the designated tag is not turned over, the tag is removed and marked with a line through the number and is initialed by the Draw Supervisor. The tag will then be posted for display each week. The amount in the Grandstand Tag jackpot then carries forward to the next draw, adding another 30% ticket sales the next week, and so on.

11. The remaining tags are then displayed to show that tag #52 YE is still in play. The tags will be secured in a locked safe at the Yorkton Exhibition between draws.

12. Once that week's draw is concluded all tickets will be removed and new tickets must be purchased for a chance to be in next week's draw.

13. Each week is a new draw with no carryover of tickets sold in previous weeks.

14. The raffle will continue until tag #52 YE is drawn or until the maximum number of tickets available has been sold, in which case advance notice will be announced as to the final play out date.

a. On this final play out date the first ticket drawn will be awarded 20% of the weekly sales and the first chance to pick for tag #52 YE.

b. If they do not select tag #52 YE, the 2nd ticket drawn will then get a chance to pick and so on, until tag #52 YE is drawn.

c. Only the first person picked will receive the 20% of the weekly sales, all others will only have a chance at 30% of the weekly sales and the jackpot.

d. On this play out draw date there will be a limit of 100 tickets total per person sold in order to

give everyone a chance to play.

e. If a person whose name is drawn does not step forward within 90 seconds after the name being called three times, the Proxy will pick for that person.

15. Once tag #52 YE is revealed the game is concluded and SLGA is notified immediately.

16. The raffle may begin again if less than 75% of the original raffle tickets have been sold; if over 75% of the tickets have been sold and it is beyond 6 months from the start of the raffle, the Yorkton Agricultural & Industrial Exhibition Association Ltd. will make a request to SLGA that the raffle license be ended.

17. Proof of purchase and photo ID must be provided before draw or winnings can be claimed.

18. For promotional purposes, the Grandstand Tag prize winner will automatically be deemed to grant the Yorkton Exhibition Association the right to publish through all types of media broadcasting including internet, their full name and photograph without any claim for broadcasting, printing or other rights.
