



# Yorkton Exhibition 2024 Light Horse Show



**Entry Deadline – FRIDAY JUNE 21, 2024**

## GENERAL RULES

1. The Show will be held under the rules and regulations of the S.H.F. Heritage Handbook. The Show committee reserves the right to decide any point not covered by the rules and to correct any errors in the prize list.
2. Should any questions or disputes arise not covered in the rules it shall be referred to the show committee whose decision will be final.
3. Nominated riders are eligible to earn points from placings in Heritage classes and these points will count towards year end awards. Please ensure your SHF membership is current and that you have nominated if you are interested in accumulating points for the awards. To qualify for Heritage Provincial Finals Sept 20-22, 2024; you must attend a minimum of two Heritage shows and have placed in the top 5 in a division to be eligible.
4. In the Hunter Division: A horse/rider combination may compete in a maximum of 3 consecutive heights per day; a horse may compete in a maximum of four over fences classes per day which applies to combined Hunter classes.
5. The Hunter Horse must be very neat and well presented. Braiding of the manes and sometimes tails for showing is optional.
6. English Attire: Hunt coats of a conservative colour (black, navy, hunter green, dark brown) should be worn. Breeches should be light coloured. Traditional black boots should be worn but paddock boots (Black or brown) may be used with matching smooth leather half chaps (no suede). Younger riders may wear paddock boots with jodhpur pants and straps. Hair must be net and contained in a net or braid. At the discretion of the judge, mandatory use of hunt coats may be waived if weather is excessively hot or humid.
7. No person other than officials may enter the ring without the permission of the show committee.
8. **Class may be combined or cancelled if there are less than 3 entries.** Entry fees will be refunded if a class is cancelled. All changes will be announced or printed.
9. In the case of any animal being disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize shall take the prize that was awarded to the disqualified animal and the other prizes adjusted accordingly.
10. Protective head gear with properly secured and fastened harness must be worn by all Riders and leaders, they must be properly fitted and in good condition and must be approved ASTM/SEI helmets. These must be worn in the Show Ring and the Warm-Up Ring
11. All youth under the age of 18 years as of January 1 of the current year are required to wear an approved ASTM/SEI helmet when participating in any competition sanctioned by the Saskatchewan Horse Federation for insurance purposes and must be wearing a helmet while mounted anywhere on the grounds. The Yorkton Exhibition Association Light Horse Show will be enforcing this rule. If you have a concern with this ruling, include it in writing with your entry.
12. Age of Rider will be as of January 1, 2024; as follows.  
PEEWEE: 8 years and under  
JR. C: 11 years and under  
JR. B: 12-14 years

JR. A: 15-17 years  
SENIOR: 18 years and over

13. Age of the horse is as of January 1, 2024. Jr. Horses are 5 years and under and may be shown in a snaffle bridle and two hands may be used.
14. A horse may not be used by more than one rider in the same event. A horse may be shown in Jr. A barrels and Peewee Poles but not in Jr. A Barrels and Jr. B barrels. With the exception of Peewee classes, which a horse may be used by a Peewee and any other age rider at the show.
15. A rider may show no more than 2 horses in an individually judged class, for example: Trail, Reining, etc.
16. Exhibitors are to be at the hitching ring when their class is called. The gate will be held for tack changes when notified, for no more than 3 minutes.
17. Correct number is to be worn on the rider's back.
18. The classes will run in the order listed in the prize list.
19. Handlers of stallions must be adult competitors.
20. If you must bring a dog, we ask that it be kept on a leash and away from the ring.

Exhibitors cancelling entries must notify the secretary before the class. Entry fee will be refunded with a certificate from a veterinarian. A substitute may be accepted, but only for the classes originally entered. Any additional classes would be a post entry.

### **RULES & REGULATIONS**

1. The entry form enclosed must be completed and received in our office by **June 21, 2024**. ***LATE entries accepted at double entry fee. NO EXCEPTIONS. THIS RULE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED!*** No entry or entry fee is required for Championship Class.
2. Show office at the barns will be open from 7:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m. July 3rd Competitors are welcome to register and make any necessary entry changes at this time.
3. Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, groom or rider may disqualify the entry. Proper etiquette is expected of exhibitors and family members both in and out of the arena.
4. Multiple entries by horses and riders are allowed as long as neither competes against themselves.
5. Stallions must be ridden and handled by adults. No stallions in 4-H Show. Stallions must be attended to properly.
6. Barn space will be available July 3rd, 2024. Limited 8' x 8' box and tack stalling at a cost of \$21/stall. Exhibitors are responsible for their horses' bedding. Stalls must be cleaned, or an additional fee will be charged. Please indicate on your entry form if you are booking a stall.

7. SHF Helmet Policy: All youth under the age of 18 as determined by their year of birth as it appears on their birth certificate will be required to wear an approved ASTM/SEI helmet when participating in any event sanctioned by the Saskatchewan Horse Federation. This is for safety and insurance purposes.
8. There will be no cross entering between Clover Bud and other Junior classes.
9. All exhibitors must follow posted ring regulations.
- 10. The committee may cancel or combine any classes that have 3 or fewer entries.**
11. Horses shall not be punished unnecessarily or severely.
12. The committee reserves the right to call a veterinarian to inspect horses suspected of being ill or lame and to remove these horses.
- 13. No liquor allowed in barns.**
14. Liability waiver must be signed and turned in before being allowed to show.
15. All individuals 6 and over entering the Yorkton Exhibition Grounds will be charged gate admission at \$12/day (6-17 yrs) or \$20/day (18+ yrs). As a **competitor**, you will receive one (1) complimentary 4-day pass and can purchase additional gate admission passes in advance for Youth (6-17 yrs) at \$10/day or \$30/4-day or Adult (18+) at \$15/day or \$45/4-day.

***Box stalls and tack stalls are available for rent for \$21.00 each includes GST. Competitors are responsible for their own bedding. Please indicate on your entry form if you will require a stall.***

## **Ranch Riding (formerly Ranch Horse Pleasure)**

The purpose of Ranch Riding should stimulate a horse riding outside the confines of an arena and the horse should reflect the versatility, attitude, and movement of a working horse. This class is judged on the horse's ability to work at a forward working speed while performing the required and optional maneuvers. The required maneuvers are the walk, jog, and lope (both directions). The extended trot and extended lope at least one direction as well as stops, back, and one change of direction. The optional maneuvers are side pass; turns of 360 degrees or more; change of lead (simple or flying); walk, jog or lope over poles or other reasonable maneuvers a ranch horse could perform. Scoring is on a 0–100-point scale with 70 denoting an average performance.
