Show Information

ENTRY LIMIT: Entries will be limited to 250 steers/heifers and will be accepted on a first come basis.

ENTRY DEADLINE: April 11, 2025

ARRIVAL: Barns will be open on Tuesday, April 22nd for arrival between 12 noon and 3pm. **THE CATTLE MUST BE IN THE BARN BY 3:00 PM - NO EXCEPTIONS!**

RELEASE: Animals will be released at the **END** of the show following the awards presentation on Thursday, April 24th, 2025.

TRAILER PARKING: All 4-H trucks and trailers must park in the far East portion of the parking lot by Tim Horton's (along East fence).

STABLING: Cattle will be stabled in the Ag Arena & Industrial Building. 4-H Clubs MUST stable animals together. There is to be NO advertising of any kind of individual farms. **NO STRAW WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE BARNS**.

TIE OUTS: Available between the cattle buildings at the owners' risk. **Tie-outs will be designated by the club**. First bedding of straw will be provided. **Additional straw is the 4-H member's responsibility.**

WEIGHING: 3:00 PM – 4:00 PM, Tuesday, April 22nd. It is preferred that all animals come together as a club to weigh. All workshop and show entries will be finalized at this time.

TEAM GROOMING: Must confirm participation by 3 PM on April 22nd. All participants are asked to meet in the show arena at 4:30 PM for the announcement of teams.

WASH RACK: Open from 6 AM - 11 PM and during Show hours - enter from EAST door ONLY.

CLIPPING/TRIMMING: All clipping/trimming is to be done in designated areas ONLY and is to be done by the 4-H member. All trim chutes MUST have Club Identification posted on chute.

** ONLY 4-H MEMBERS MAY FIT ANIMALS FOR THE SHOW. IF ADULT PARTICIPATION TAKES PLACE (relating to washing, grooming & fitting), THAT ANIMAL WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SHOW - NO EXCEPTIONS. **

CCIA TAGS: ALL CATTLE MUST BE CCIA TAGGED. - No exceptions!

** NO BUCKET HEATERS ALLOWED **

Please ensure that ALL birth dates and breeds are correct. There will absolutely be NO changes after the deadline date.

LIABILITY: Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein contained, it is understood that each exhibitor waives all claims against the Yorkton Exhibition Assoc., and/or any of its members, officials, or agents thereof, for any and all injury, loss, damage, which he/she, his/her employees, helpers, and/or property may sustain by the said Association by reason of any claims made by any of his helpers or assistants introduced to or engaged shall be at the sole risk and responsibility of such exhibitor.

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Any exhibitor not complying with the rules and regulations made to govern exhibitors and their exhibits during the show may, at the discretion of the Directors, forfeit all or any portion of the prize money won with his/her exhibits.
- 2. All entered exhibitors shall be under the control of the Association, but they will in no case be responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may occur. It shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Association blameless for any loss, accident, or injury.
- 3. The decisions of the judges shall be final.
- 4. The Committee reserves the right to decide any points not covered by the prize list, and in all cases, their decision shall be final.
- 5. Alcoholic beverages and smoking will not be allowed in the Barn. This will be enforced.
- 6. NO BUCKET HEATERS ALLOWED.
- 7. All Cattle MUST be CCIA tagged.
- 8. Only dehorned or polled animals are eligible to be shown in the steer classes. Scurs are not to be greater than 2 inches (5cm) in length.
- 9. Cattle must be well halter broken. No vicious or unruly animals may be shown or be kept in stables with any other exhibitors.
- 10. All entries must be in the hands of the Yorkton Exhibition Office by 4:30 PM, FRIDAY, APRIL 11th, 2025.

 No changes and/or substitutions will be accepted after the entry deadline date or at weigh-in.
- 11. All CLUB entries must be done as ONE club, with ONE cheque. Club leaders will be responsible for reviewing & making sure all information is correctly filled out prior to submission of entry. Club leaders may be contacted to review entries with the Committee.
- 12. The show is open to 4-H members and Clover Bud Exhibitors under the age of 21 years as of December 31, 2024.

Clover Bud – Between 6 & 8 years of age as of December 31, 2024 Junior – Between 9 & 12 years of age as of December 31, 2024 Intermediate – Between 13 & 15 years of age as of December 31, 2024 Senior – Between 16 & 21 years of age as of December 31, 2024

- 13. Each participant may show one steer and/or heifer. Clover Bud participants are eligible to show in the regular show with paid entry.
- 14. It is mandatory to be entered in the Open Show before entering the Jackpot Show.
- 15. Entry into Showmanship classes is automatic and mandatory. All Showmanship classes will be DRY FIT no exceptions!
- 16. All Heifers/Steers entered in the Show must be the members' own 4-H project animal.
- 17. All participants must wear a show harness when in the ring.
- 18. Heifers will be split by breed and if there are not 3 animals per class, they will be put into a mixed breed class and split by age.
- 19. Purebreds not in a breed class of at least 3 animals will be entered in an "all other purebreds" class.

- 20. Group Classes Clover Bud Exhibitors & bona fide members enrolled in a 4-H Beef Club are eligible to compete. All animals must have been shown in the Open Show single classes.
- 21. No ribbons won in previous classes are allowed to be carried into the show ring.
- 22. The exhibitor whose name is on the entry form at the time of entry is the person responsible for showing the said animal(s). NO OTHER family member or exhibitor will be allowed in the show ring with the said animal(s), notwithstanding Clover Buds. No other exceptions to this rule will be made.
- 23. Any false representation, interference, or ungentlemanly conduct on the part of an exhibitor or parent will be dealt with by the Committee according to each case.
- 24. It is the responsibility of the 4-H members to keep the barn area and clipping area clean throughout the Show and to remove manure nightly.
- 25. Only current 4-H members and Clover Bud Exhibitors are allowed to fit (wash, clip, groom) calves. ONLY current 4-H members can be listed as helpers and can assist other members. 4-H members that are helpers MUST be identified to the show committee by 8:30 a.m. each morning and MUST wear provided identification at all times. When safety is an issue, handling of the animal by a parent or leader may be permitted. This rule will be policed by the Committee. Any entries found to violate this rule will be disqualified.
- 26. The expectation of the committee is that if a 4-H member is attending the show as a 4-H helper, they are available to help all kids and all clubs. The show committee encourages 4-H members and clubs to reach out to the identified helpers for assistance.
