**RULES & REGULATIONS**

1. Judges decisions are final. Questions and concerns are to be directed to the show committee. Show will be held under the rules and regulations of the S.H.F. Heritage Handbook. The show committee reserves the right to make decisions on any matters not addressed in the rules and to correct any errors in the prize list.
2. Should any questions or disputes arise not covered in the rules it shall be referred to the show committee whose decision will be final.
3. Nominated riders are eligible to earn points from placings in Heritage classes and these points will count towards year end awards. Please ensure your SHF membership is current and that you have nominated if you are interested in accumulating points for the awards. To qualify for Heritage Provincial Finals Sept 19-21, 2026; you must attend a minimum of two Heritage shows and have placed in the top 5 in a division to be eligible.
4. Stallions must be ridden and handled by adults. No stallions in 4-H classes. Stallions must be attended to properly.
5. English Attire: Hunt coats of a conservative colour (black, navy, hunter green, dark brown) should be worn. Breeches should be light coloured. Traditional black boots should be worn but paddock boots (Black or brown) may be used with matching smooth leather half chaps (no suede). Younger riders may wear paddock boots with jodhpur pants and straps. Hair must be neat and contained in a net or braid. At the discretion of the judge, mandatory use of hunt coats may be waived is weather if excessively hot or humid.  
  
Western Attire: A shirt with long sleeves and collar, western hat (if rider is over 19) or approved helmet, western pants with a belt, and cowboy boots. Spurs, chaps, and gloves are optional.
6. No person other than officials may enter the ring without the permission of the show committee.
7. Horses shall not be punished unnecessarily or severely. Any animal that exhibits any types of abuse will be excused by the show committee.
8. The show committee reserves the right to call a veterinarian to inspect horses of being ill or lame and to remove these horses.
9. Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, groom or rider may disqualify the entry. Proper etiquette is expected of exhibitors and family members both in and out of the arena.
10. Rider fall is automatic disqualification.
11. In the case of any animal being disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize shall take the prize that was awarded to the disqualified animal and the other prizes adjusted accordingly.
12. SHF Helmet Policy: All youth under the age of 18 as determined by their year of birth as it appears on their birth certificate will be required to wear an approved ASTM/SEI helmet when participating in any event sanctioned by the Saskatchewan Horse Federation. This is for safety and insurance purposes.

13. Age of Rider will be **as of January 1, 2026**; as follows.  
 PEEWEE/CLOVERBUD: 8 years and under  
 JR. C: 11 years and under  
 JR. B: 12-14 years  
 JR. A: 15-18 years  
 SENIOR: 19 years and over
14. Age of the horse is as of January 1, 2026. Jr. Horses are 5 years and under and may be shown in a snaffle bridle and two hands may be used.
15. A horse may not be used by more than one rider in the same class.
16. A rider may show no more than 2 horses in an individually judged class, for example: Trail, Ranch Riding, & Hunter etc.
17. Exhibitors are to be at the hitching ring when their class is called. The gate will be held for tack changes when notified, for no more than 3 minutes.
18. Correct number is to be worn on the rider's back.
19. The classes will run in the order listed in the prize list.
20. Late entries accepted at double entry fees.

Entry Fees: \$5.00 per class (**unless stated otherwise**)

Exhibitors cancelling entries must notify the secretary before the class. Entry fee will be refunded with a certificate from a veterinarian. A substitute may be accepted, but only for the classes originally entered. Any additional classes would be a post entry.

### **General Information**

1. The Yorkton Exhibition Show office will be open from 5:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. July 1<sup>st</sup>. Competitors are welcome to register and make any necessary entry changes at this time.
2. Barn space will be available July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026. Limited 8' x 8' box and tack stalling at a cost of \$21/stall. Exhibitors are responsible for their horses' bedding. Stalls must be cleaned, or an additional fee will be charged. Please indicate on your entry form if you are booking a stall.
3. All exhibitors must follow posted ring regulations.
4. **No liquor allowed in barns.**
5. Liability waiver must be signed and turned in before being allowed to show.
6. If you must bring a dog, we ask that it be kept on a leash and away from the ring.
7. All individuals 6 and over entering the Yorkton Exhibition Grounds will be charged gate admission at \$18/day (6-17 yrs) or \$25/day (18+ yrs). As a **competitor**, you will receive one (1) complimentary 4-day pass and can purchase additional gate admission passes in advance for Youth (6-17 yrs) at \$35/day or \$50/4-day for Adult (18+)

## **4-H RULES & REGULATIONS**

1. 4-H classes are open to 4-H members only.
2. Stallions are not permitted in 4-H classes.
3. All members in the light horse project must wear an approved ASTM/SEI riding helmet with a strap when participating at all 4-H Events.
4. Late entries accepted at double entry fee.
5. Order of events will be as the classes are listed in this book.
6. All General Rules & Regulations, which are applicable, shall apply to this show.
